LAW MODIFYING IN ITS ENTIRETY CHAPTER 10 BICYCLES OF THE  
SALTAIRE VILLAGE CODE

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE  
INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF SALTAIRE AS FOLLOWS:

3.0 Severability and Validity.

Section 1.0 Title, Enactment, Effective Date and Purpose.

1.1. Title.

This Local Law shall be entitled, "Local Law No.      of 2022: A Local  
Law Modifying Section 10- 3 (H) Chapter 10 Bicycles of the Saltaire  
Village Code".

1.2 Enactment.

Pursuant to Section 10 of the Home Rule Law, the Village Law and the  
Village Code of the Incorporated Village of Saltaire, the Incorporated Village of  
Saltaire, County of Suffolk and State of New York, hereby enacts by this Local  
Law No.      of 2022, a Local Law of the Incorporated Village of Saltaire.

1.3. Effective Date.

This local law shall take effect on the filing of the approved Local Law  
with the Secretary of State of New York, which shall be within twenty (20) days  
after its approval by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of Saltaire.

1.4. Purpose and Intent of Local Law.

A. The purpose and intent of this local law is to adopt regulations which will provide for and ensure the safety of the residents, guests and visitors of the Village of Saltaire by the adoption of this Local Law containing those regulations pursuant to Article 10 of the New York State Village Law.

1.5 Findings.

The Board of Trustees hereby finds:

A. That the predominant forms of transportation on the public walkways within the Village of Saltaire are pedestrian foot traffic, including many children and family groups, and bicycles, and that the intersections, width, sight lines and other characteristics of the public walks in the Village of Saltaire require bicycle riders to adhere to certain restrictions for the general health safety and welfare for all users of the public walkways in the Village of Saltaire.

2.0 General Provisions.

2.1 Section 10- 3 (H) of Chapter 10 of the Saltaire Village Code is hereby created to read as follows:

**§ 10-3. Operation and use. [Amended 8-27-1988 by L.L. No. 3, 1988; 4-21-1990 by L.L. No. 4, 1990; 9-10-22 by L.L. No X, 2022]**

H. No person operating a bicycle shall at any time walk a dog or other animal while simultaneously operating the bicycle. No animal shall be hand-carried by an operator of a bicycle, or otherwise transported or ridden on a bicycle, unless the dog is in a basket attached to the bicycle, or if the animal must be transported because it is sick or injured.

3.0 Severability and Validity

3.1 In the event that any portion or section of this Local Law may be determined to be invalid, the remaining portions and sections of this Local Law shall remain in full force and effect.
