Subject: PERMITS FOR 2012 MARINA SLIPS & BAY FRONT BEACHING

Enclosed please find the 2012 application forms for Marina Slips and Mooring Permits for homeowners and renters residing in the Village of Saltaire.

MARINA SLIP REGULATIONS

1. No boat may remain at any slip or dock or on a mooring anywhere in the Saltaire bayfront without a permit.
2. **COMPLETE APPLICATIONS AND FEES FOR MARINA SLIPS MUST BE RECEIVED BY FEBRUARY 15th IN ORDER FOR RETURNING BOAT OWNERS TO RESERVE THEIR PLACE IN THE MARINA**
3. All boats in the marina are required to carry public liability insurance in amount no less than \$300,000 for both bodily injury and property damage on either their homeowners liability insurance, yacht insurance policy or however their liability insurance is provided. **A BOAT OWNER MUST PROVIDE THE INC. VILLAGE OF SALTIRE WITH A CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE AS EVIDENCE OF SUCH COVERAGE BEFORE A SLIP WILL BE ASSIGNED. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
4. Home Owner applications have priority over applications received from renters.
5. Slips will be assigned in the following order:
 - a) Applications for the SAME slip held last year.
 - b) Applications for a CHANGE of slip which will be assigned based upon availability.
 - c) New applications. Priority will be determined by placement on waiting list.
6. The slip is assigned by the Village Administrator and may be changed at his discretion in order to more efficiently utilize the available slips for the benefit of all Saltaire boat owners.
7. Due to overwhelming demands from full season home owners, subleasing of slips will not be permitted without Village permission.
8. If a slip is left vacant for any continuous four-week period during July and August, the Village shall have the right to revoke the permit.

9. Boat owners who are unable to secure slips may anchor east of Pacific Walk or west of the marina, subject to an approved mooring application along with payment of the requisite fee.
10. Only one boat is permitted per slip. Sharing of a slip is not permitted
11. No boats over 35 feet long will be permitted in a marina slip.
12. Saltaire village permit stickers must be affixed to all boats in the marina. The permit sticker must be displayed in a place on the boat visible from the dock.
13. Temporary use authorized by the permittee will be allowed at the discretion of the Village, and the temporary user must provide his/her boat registration number, boat description and evidence of liability insurance delivered to the Village office in advance of the temporary use. Such use will not be authorized for more than 48 hours during any two-week cycle.
14. Any change of ownership of a boat at an assigned slip must be reported promptly in writing to the Village office.
15. Boat operators must observe navigation rules leaving and entering the marina. Marina speed limit is 5 mph.
16. No engine or noise producing device, other than alarm systems, shall be operated between the hours of 8:00 P.M. and 8:00 A.M. except when a boat is underway or during the short periods prior to or subsequent to such operation.
17. No person is permitted to use a boat for living quarters while in the marina.
18. All boats must be kept in good appearance, properly secured and pumped out. No person may keep any rigging or boat material of any kind on the docks or bulkhead.
19. No refuse or material of any kind may be deposited in the marina. Toilets may not be flushed in or near the marina or anywhere near the Saltaire docks or bay front. No gasoline or oil may be discharged in the marina.
20. No commercial boats are allowed in the marina without Village approval. Boats employed for harvesting shellfish for sale where the owner or operator has a license for such harvesting shall be considered to be in commercial use.
21. A slip permit may be withdrawn at the discretion of the Board of Trustees for any violation of the above rules.

SLIP PERMIT INSTRUCTIONS

Submission of a photocopy of the current New York State certificate of Boat Registration and a Certificate of Liability Insurance must be attached to the application. When the application, fee and required certificates are received, the slip number will be assigned and the applicant will be notified. Please indicate on the enclosed diagram of the Marina your first, second and third location preferences. Every effort will be made to accommodate you, but because of our limited facilities applicants may be assigned a slip other than the one requested. Please note that slip widths are measured from pole center to pole center and are approximations only. All permits are issued subject to the Saltaire Marina Regulations. Noncompliance with any regulation may result in the issuance of a summons and revocation of permit without refund.

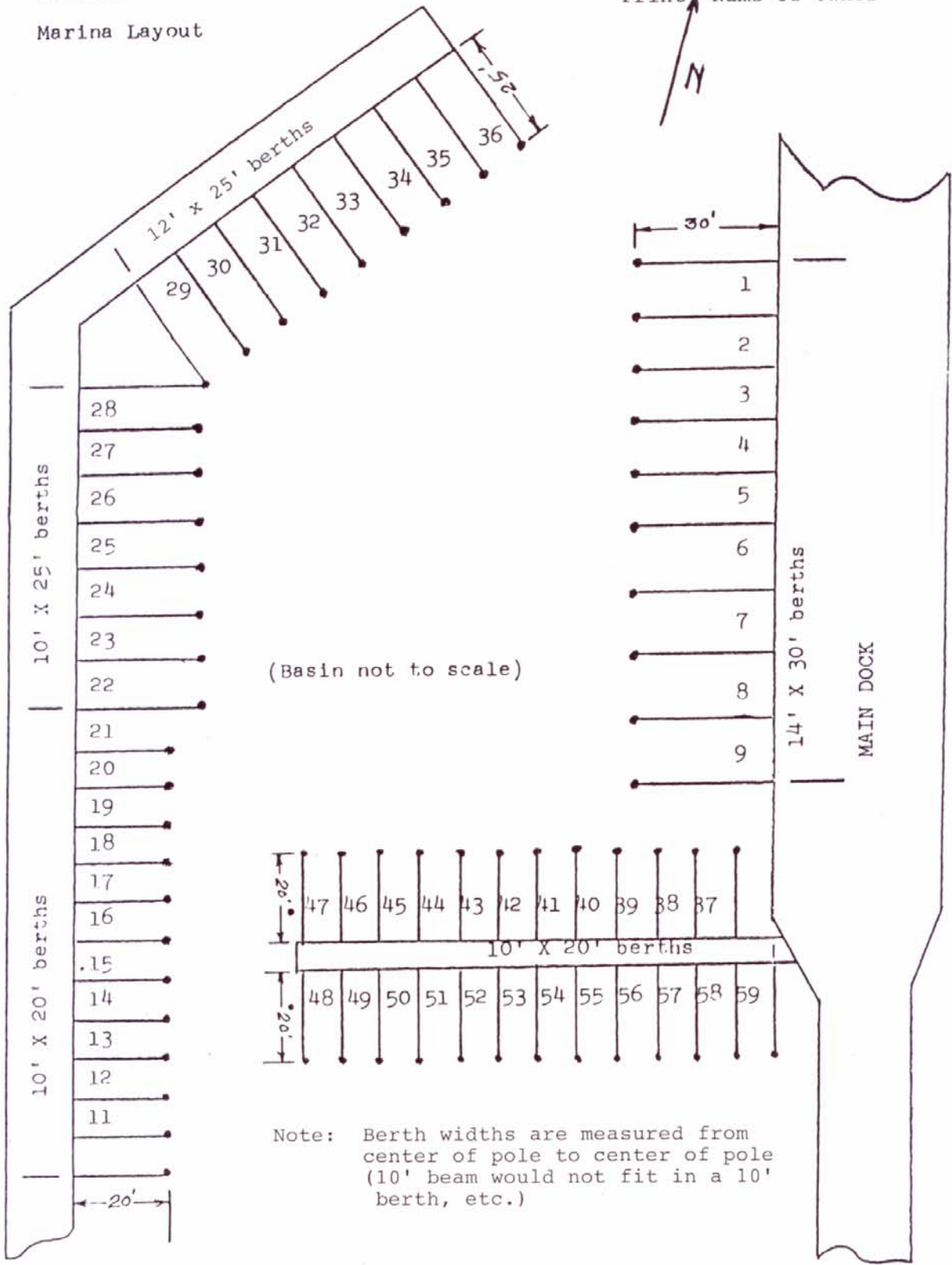
