

A LOCAL LAW NO. 7 OF 2008 OF THE VILLAGE OF SALTAIRE AMENDING SECTION 50-15(B) OF THE VILLAGE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF SALTAIRE REGARDING REVOCATION OF PERMITS WHICH SHALL BE KNOWN AS “LOCAL LAW NO. 7 OF 2008: AMENDMENT TO SECTION 50-15(B) OF THE SALTAIRE VILLAGE CODE REGARDING REVOCATION OF PERMITS”.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF SALTAIRE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.0 Title, Enactment, Effective Date and Purpose.

1.1. Title

This Local Law shall be entitled, "Local Law No. 7 of 2008: Amendment to Section 50-15(B) of the Saltaire Village Code Regarding Revocation of Permits.”

1.2. Enactment.

Pursuant to Section 10 of the Home Rule Law, the Village Law and the Village Code of the Incorporated Village of Saltaire, the Incorporated Village of Saltaire, County of Suffolk and State of New York, hereby enacts by this Local Law No. 7 of 2008, a Local Law of the Incorporated Village of Saltaire.

1.3. Effective Date.

This local law shall take effect on the filing of the approved Local Law with the Secretary of State of New York, which shall be within twenty (20) days after its approval by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of Saltaire.

1.4. Purpose and Intent of Local Law.

The purpose of this Local Law is to promote and protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of and visitors to the Village of Saltaire; to preserve, protect and enhance the environment and aesthetic assets of the Village of Saltaire, including the environmentally sensitive areas within the boundaries of the Village; and to safeguard the value of public and private property within the Village of Saltaire, by establishing amendments to Section 50-15(B) of the Saltaire Village Code regarding revocation of permits.

2.0 General Provisions.

2.1 Amendment to Section 50-15(B) of the Saltaire Village Code

Section 50-15(B) of the Village Code of the Village of Saltaire is hereby amended to read as follows:

B. Any permit holder who shall have three (3) adjudicated violations in the Village Justice Court of any Section(s) of this Chapter during any period of eighteen (18) months shall be subject, at the sole discretion of the Village Administrator, to immediate revocation of any or all current permits issued under the provisions of this Chapter in the permit holder's name and to the denial of any or all future permits for which the permit holder may apply under this Chapter for a period of time as shall be determined by the Village Administrator, but in no case shall said period of time exceed twelve (12) months commencing from the date of such revocation. For purposes of this Section "permit holder" shall be defined as any individual or entity or any entity in which such individual or entity has any interest as a manager, member, officer, owner or partner, and "adjudication violation" shall include a guilty plea to a violation.

C. Any permit holder who has received a notice of revocation of any or all current or future permit(s) pursuant to this Chapter, shall have the automatic right of appeal directly to

the Board of Trustees, which appeal must be made in writing to the Board of Trustees within thirty days of the notice of revocation from the Village Administrator. The revocation of permit shall be suspended during the period starting from the request for an appeal until a decision is rendered by the Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees has the sole discretion to uphold, overturn or modify the original decision of the Village Administrator.

3.0 Severability and Validity

In the event that any portion or portions of this Local Law of 2008 shall be determined to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of the Local Law, and its provisions, shall remain in full force and effect.
