



IMPORTANT RULES AND REGULATIONS VILLAGE OF SALTAIRE



OUTDOOR COOKING

- Outdoor cooking (“barbecuing”) shall not be permitted in the Village of Saltaire except (i) by use of a propane gas-powered grill or any other heat source approved by the Board of Trustees and (ii) if the owner of the property on which the outdoor cooking is to be conducted holds a valid Outdoor Cooking Permit obtained by application at the Village Office. **No other outdoor cooking or fires are permitted.**
- **Outdoor cooking is permitted only between 12 noon and 9:00 PM.**
- Grills must be attended at all times during use and be kept well clear of any combustible material, 15 feet from any adjacent house, and rest upon a fire retardant platform. **Grills are prohibited on second floor decks without direct exterior egress to the ground.**
- Outdoor grills and propane tank installations are subject to inspection by the Village Fire Marshal. Property owners are responsible for the safe and lawful use of grills by family members, guests and tenants. Grills must be maintained in proper working order and comply with all requirements and regulations of the Village Code and the New York State Fire Prevention Code.
- All propane tanks must be installed, used, maintained and removed in accordance with Village regulations. Propane tanks used for grilling on all properties other than those of year-round residents must be removed from the village by no later than November 30 of each year and may not be brought back until April 1 of a subsequent year.
- **Annual permit required for all propane and other natural gas tanks.**

PEACE AND GOOD ORDER

- **Keep off the dunes at all times.**
- No outdoor construction from the Friday before Memorial Day through September 15 without permission.
- Occasional use of light residential equipment is permitted: weekdays, 9 AM - 5 PM; weekends: 11 AM - 4 PM.
- No playing of radios in public places except through personal listening devices. Unreasonable noise prohibited.
- No food or drink (except water) allowed on any beaches. No open containers of alcohol on walks or other public places.
- No sports activities in protected swimming areas of bay and ocean beaches.

ANIMALS

- Dogs must be on a leash at **all times** except when on owner’s property.
- Person in control of dog(s) must immediately remove and properly dispose of all fecal matter.
- Dogs are **prohibited** on docks (except going to or coming from the ferry) and bayfront at all times, and on oceanfront between 8 AM – 6 PM.
- Feeding of deer is prohibited by local, state and federal laws.

WATER USAGE

- Watering of plants or gardens is prohibited from 4 PM -7 PM daily, from the Friday before Memorial Day through September 15. **Turn off all water-using devices if fire alarm sounds.**

BICYCLE USE

- No person shall ride or operate a bicycle in a dangerous, reckless or careless manner or at a speed of more than 8 MPH at any time. **Bike riding prohibited on docks.**
- Night bike riding is prohibited from the Friday before Memorial Day until September 15. Night bike riding is permitted from September 16 through the Thursday before Memorial Day, provided rider uses a light whose beam shall be plainly visible at least 200 feet ahead.
- No passengers or other persons shall be permitted on a bicycle or other pedal-operated or foot-propelled vehicle or device in excess of the number which such vehicle or device is designed to carry. **Riding with small children in a basket, on handlebars, or in any other manner except in an attached child safety seat is strictly prohibited.** New York State Law requires that children under 14 years of age wear a safety helmet while on a bicycle.
- All bicycles ridden within the Village shall be equipped with a working bell. Riders must slow down and sound bell at all intersections. As a courtesy and for your safety, ring your bell or call out when passing a rider or pedestrian.
- **Blocking any Village walkway with a bicycle is prohibited. Pull off walks to allow Emergency Services vehicles the right of way.**
- You may register your bicycle with Security, free of charge.
Use of skateboards, rollerblades, roller skates or any similar apparatus is prohibited within the Village.
