



GENERAL COVID GUIDELINES
DEVELOPED IN CONSULTATION WITH THE MAC
6-11-2021

BACKGROUND

Given that the current CDC guidelines state that fully-vaccinated individuals can engage in the following activities without wearing masks pursuant to the following:

Everyone should:

- *Follow CDC and NYS guidelines in all circumstances*

Fully vaccinated people can:

- *Resume activities without wearing masks or physically distancing, except where required by federal, state, local, tribal, or territorial laws, rules and regulations, including local business and workplace guidance*

and further given that there is no practical way to determine who in the general public has been vaccinated, the following guidelines are recommended for

various activities and places for individuals that are ages 12 and older. Individuals 11 or younger are to follow CDC and NYS guidelines.

1. PUBLIC WALKS, BEACHES OR OTHER PUBLIC AREAS:

- a. Masks will NOT be required or enforced on public walkways, beaches or in other public areas for anyone (including Village Employees).
- b. Emphasis will be placed on personal responsibility, individual level of comfort, and the communal respect for the rights and health of other members of the community.

2. PUBLIC SOCIAL GATHERINGS

- a. July 4th Beach Party is on, but with:
- b. Bay Picnic: Approved to Proceed
 - i. Will be moved to east side of Broadway for extra room
- c. Fireworks: CANCELED FOR 2021
- d. Arts and Crafts Festival:
 - i. Permitted without masks but with set-up restrictions to promote social distancing and to limit large gatherings in one place.
- e. Live Animal Presentations: CANCELLED FOR 2021

3. PLAYGROUND

- a. Masking at the discretion of the parents.
- b. Enforcement: Self-Regulated

4. SOFTBALL LEAGUE:

- a. Full League schedule starts June 26th.
- b. Vaccinated Players do not have to wear masks while playing and are encouraged to wear masks while in the bleachers to protect spectators.
- c. Bleachers will open for the start of the regularly scheduled League Play. Signage will be posted stating that non-vaccinated spectators must wear masks but they will be self-regulated and non-segregated,

therefore all other spectators should wear face-coverings to their own level of comfort.

d. Enforcement: Self-Regulated

5. BASKETBALL

a. Maximum Capacity as follows for now:

- i. Half Court games limited to 4 players versus 4 players
- ii. Full Court games limited to 5 players versus 5 players
- iii. Enforcement: Self-Regulated

6. SOCCER

a. Maximum Capacity as follows

- i. Half Field Games of 5 players versus 5 players, plus goalies.
- ii. Full Field Games of 10 players versus 10 players, plus goalies.
- iii. Enforcement: Enforcement: Self-Regulated

7. COURTESY CART

a. Equipment: Continue to use Plexiglass Dividers

b. Usage: To Ferry and Saltaire Clinic Only is the primary purpose, and all other requests will be considered on a case-by-case basis depending on staffing and volume of requests.

8. BEACH OPERATIONS

a. Will follow NYS guidance for Public Beaches

b. Public Chair program reinstated June 20th – the start of the full lifeguard season.

9. SALTAIRE DAY CAMP

a. Under the auspices of the Camp Director and Camp Medical Director, Policies and Procedures for Campers and Staff will be developed, implemented and adjusted pursuant to NYS Department of Health Guidelines for Day Camps for both outdoor and indoor activities.

10.SALTAIRE YACHT CLUB

a. DINING:

- i. Exterior Dining at maximum capacity, with diners not required to wear masks and servers wearing masks.
- ii. Interior Dining: Pursuant to NYS COVID current Guidance. Servers wearing masks.
- iii. Bar: Pursuant to NYS COVID current Guidance and SLA requirements
- iv. Enforcement: Self-Regulated

b. TENNIS

- i. No masks required during game play.
- ii. Must follow CDC guidelines for social distancing for all Clinics, Tournaments and Spectators.
- iii. Enforcement: Self-Regulated

c. SAILING

- i. Follow NYS & CDC Guidelines
- ii. Enforcement: Self-Regulated

11.OUTDOOR WATER FACILITIES

- a. Showers and Foot Showers: Open for Season
- b. Hand Washing Stations Open for Season
- c. Hand Sanitizing Stations Open for Season
- d. Water Fountains: Stations Open for season

12.FERRY OPERATION

- a. Pursuant to Coast Guard guidelines in place at the time.
- b. Village to monitor and encourage Fire Island Ferry compliance with Coast Guard regulations.

13.INTERIOR PUBLIC SPACES

i. Firehouse:

1. Community Room:

- a. Public: Non-vaccinated must wear masks – self regulated
 - b. Public: Vaccinated do not have to wear masks - personal level of comfort based on the knowledge that other patrons are self-regulating.
 - c. Members pursuant to Fire Co. SOGs.
 - d. Camp: Masks Required at all times
2. All Other Areas of Firehouse
- a. Public Not Allowed

ii. All other Village Buildings

1. Public

- a. Non-vaccinated must wear masks – self regulated
- b. Vaccinated do not have to wear masks - personal level of comfort based on the knowledge that other patrons are self-regulating.

14.PRIVATE (Including PLACES OF WORSHIP) INTERIOR AND EXTERIOR SPACES

- a. Requirement: Pursuant to current NYS COVID Guidelines
- b. Enforcement: Self-regulated
