A LOCAL LAW NO. OF 2022 OF THE VILLAGE OF SALTAIRE AMENDING CHAPTER 32 (MEDICAL SERVICES) OF THE SALTAIRE VILLAGE CODE TO MODIFY THE COMPOSITION AND AUTHORITY OF THE MEDICAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF SALTAIRE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.0 Title, Enactment, Effective Date and Purpose.

1.1. Title

This Local Law shall be entitled, "Local Law No. of 2022: Amendment of Chapter 32 Medical Services."

1.2. Enactment.

Pursuant to Section 10 of the Home Rule Law, the Village Law and the Village Code of the Incorporated Village of Saltaire, the Incorporated Village of Saltaire, County of Suffolk and State of New York, hereby enacts by this Local Law No. of 2022, a Local Law of the Incorporated Village of Saltaire.

1.3. Effective Date.

August 4, 2022

This Local Law shall take effect on the filing of the approved Local Law with the Secretary of State of New York, which shall be within twenty (20) days after its approval by the Board of Trustees of the Incorporated Village of Saltaire.

1.0 Purpose and Intent of Local Law.

The purpose and intent of this Local Law is to adopt provision for the composition and authority of the Medical Advisory Committee.

2.0 General Provisions.

2.1 Amendment by modifying Section 32.3 and repealing 32.4 as follows:

**§ 32-3. Medical Advisory Committee. [Amended X/X/2022 by L.L. No. X, 2022]**

- A. The Board shall appoint a Medical Advisory Committee consisting of four (4) members. The Committee shall, upon request of the Mayor, Board or Village Administrator, advise the Board on the conduct of medical services within the village, the quality thereof, the reasonableness of the fees charged therefor, and other matters of public health. Members shall be appointed to terms of three (3) years each, the terms to be staggered so that no two shall terminate in the same year; except that, upon adoption of this Section, two (2) members shall be appointed for terms of three (3) years each, said terms to run concurrently. The Mayor shall designate one member to serve as Chairman of the Committee. Members shall serve without compensation, and in carrying out their duties may consult with such additional individuals as they may deem necessary to the fulfillment of said duties.
- B. Alternate member. The Board shall appoint an Alternate Member of the Committee, who shall substitute for a member of the Medical Committee when such member is unable to participate because of a conflict of interest, or for any other reason, on a matter before the Committee. When so substituting, the Alternate Member shall possess all the powers and responsibilities of such member of the Committee. The Alternate Member shall be entitled to participate in all Committee meetings, work and discussions but shall not have a vote on the Committee unless acting as a substitute for a regular member of the Committee. The term of an Alternate Member shall be one (1) year, coincident with the appointment of a regular member in each year.

- C. Fire Company liaison. The Board shall appoint one (1) member of the Saltaire Volunteer Fire Company (SVFC) to serve as the Company's liaison with the Committee. The liaison shall be a member in good standing of the SVFC, with medical training preferred but not required, and the person so designated for appointment shall be by mutual agreement with the Chief and President of the SVFC. The liaison shall be entitled to participate in all Committee meetings, work and discussions but shall not have a vote on the Committee. The term of such liaison shall be one (1) year, coincident with the appointment of a regular member of the Committee in each year.
- D. Section 32-4 of this Chapter (“Alternate Members”) is hereby repealed.
