ACCEPTANCE OF DONATED EQUIPMENT

Village Administrator Posillico reported that Carl Ekstein has made an offer to donate an electric scooter to the Village, which can be used by less-mobile residents of the Village for transportation. AUTHORIZATION TO MAKE APPLICATION FOR HAZARD MITIGATION PROJECTS

Village Administrator Posillico reported that New York State has made available over \$500 million of funding for projects that would mitigate future flood damage in communities. The Hazard Mitigation Grant Program is available to all communities in New York State and not just disaster-declared counties. After discussion, Trustee Wolf made a motion to authorize Administrator Posillico to submit the requisite Letter of Intent as the initial step for consideration for inclusion in the program, and to file all necessary applications documents for formal application for funding under the New York States Hazard Mitigation Grant Program.
